SUMMARY/PURPOSE:

Under supervision, the Course Worker provides support to the Golf Course Maintenance department. This position is responsible for aiding the Assistant/Golf Course Superintendent with various golf course maintenance and construction activities. This position assists the Assistant/Golf Course Superintendent in the successful growth and operations of the company. Note: the distinction between these three levels of Course Worker is primarily experience and skills development.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

PROMOTE FINANCIAL STABILITY

- Assist in the maintenance and construction of new greens, tees, and fairways: activities include, but are not limited to, grading, preparing soil, and planting.
- Grade and prepare a soil plant bed; lay sod, plant vegetative material, and seed greens, tees, fairways, and roughs.
- Operate dump trucks and other light equipment in hauling materials and removing debris.
- Perform various (daily) maintenance activities:
 - Operating power equipment to mow greens, tees, fairways, and roughs.
 - Watering and fertilizing greens, tees, fairways, and roughs.
 - Trimming trees and pruning shrubbery.
 - Cultivating shrubs and flowers.
 - Changing cups and tee markers.
 - Maintaining accessories and water hazards.
 - Preserving and raking bunkers.
